This January, the ASTI is proud to launch a **free breast and prostate health assessment** service for members of the ASTI Salary Protection Scheme.

All eligible members of the ASTI Salary Protection Scheme will be invited to attend their free assessment over the coming months.

As BreastCheck is already available to females over age 50, the free breast health assessment service will be made available to ASTI Salary Protection Scheme members under the age of 50.

Blue Power will be available to men aged 40 - 65.

If you are outside of these age groups, and notice any symptoms or have concerns, please contact your GP directly.

The initiative is proudly sponsored by Irish Life, supported by Cornmarket, and delivered by Full Health Medical, Beaumont Private Clinic and Bon Secours Hospital, Dublin.

We strongly encourage all eligible members to avail of their free assessment. It only takes 15 minutes and it could save a life!

ELIGIBILITY AND FAQ'S

How do I know if I am eligible and when you are coming to my area?

If you are eligible, you will be sent an invite by email/post with all the details.

How do I book my assessment?

The details of how to book will be in your invite. A booking system has been set up to be as convenient as possible. It's all done online through the click of a button.

What if I need further tests after my initial assessment?

The findings from your initial assessment will be discussed with you after your appointment. If any further tests are needed, an appointment will be organised for you to get rapid access to a Specialist Consultant and Radiologist in Beaumont Private Clinic or Bon Secours Private Hospital, Dublin.

Do I have to pay anything?

No. This initiative is kindly sponsored by Irish Life, the insurer and supported by Cornmarket, the administrator of the ASTI Salary Protection Scheme. The cost of your initial assessment will be covered by Irish Life. If you require a referral for further tests, the cost will also be covered if you don't have health insurance, or if your health insurance falls short.

Is it confidential?

All results/information provided in relation to this programme are **strictly confidential** and will only be visible and retained by the relevant team of medical professionals.




